

Terms and conditions

Stubbings Local Markets 2025

Stallholders: Please read this entire document as it includes details of how the market will be run on the day and what is expected of the Stallholder and Stubbings Group. By booking your stall you are accepting the terms and conditions as set out below.

Easter & Winter Market Location - The Market will be outside in the Walled Garden.

Marshals will direct you as you arrive. Use SL6 6QL for sat nav.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment Terms: You will receive a link to a web page to complete your payment, and therefore securing your place in the market. Payment is due 5 working days from confirmation of place. If full payment is not made, your place will not be held.

Cancellations:

- Less than 14 days' notice of cancellation – no refund will be given
- More than 14 days' notice of cancellation – 50% refund will be returned
- Set up is from 7:30am for the Market. Please be ready to trade by 10am.
- Car Parking: Please park in the overflow car park after unloading
- Provided for you: You will be provided with space only. You will need to supply your own gazebos, tables, seating. Spaces will be allocated on a first come basis.
- If you bring a child or children with you, please note that they are your responsibility and should not be permitted to run freely around Stubbings Group. Traders should be ready to trade by 10:00am. Please make sure there are no trip hazards and walkways are not obstructed. No trader should dismantle their display at the Market before 3:00pm without prior agreement with the organiser on site. Your space is to be left tidy at the end of the day and any rubbish put in the bins. Any electrical equipment which is brought on site must be tested/certified to the appropriate standards and should carry a current PAT testing label. Electrical leads for external use must be fitted with 16A plugs. Stubbings will not be providing power to this site.
- All Stallholders have a duty of care to ensure their own Health & Safety, and also that of members of the public. They are responsible for any and all damage or injury to persons or property caused by them or their stands or any act of omission by them or their staff. Traders are responsible for holding their own Public Liability Insurance and Product Liability Insurance.
- Stubbings Group will not be responsible for damage to stock or theft whilst on the premises. No responsibility will be accepted by Stubbings Group for the security of any goods, money or equipment before, during or after the event. All transactions are between the Vendor and Purchaser alone. No responsibility will be accepted by Stubbings Group for any transactions. Stubbings Group reserves the right to cancel, curtail all or part of the event at their absolute discretion, the right to refuse access and also the right to require stallholders to leave immediately should any of the foregoing guidelines not be adhered to.
